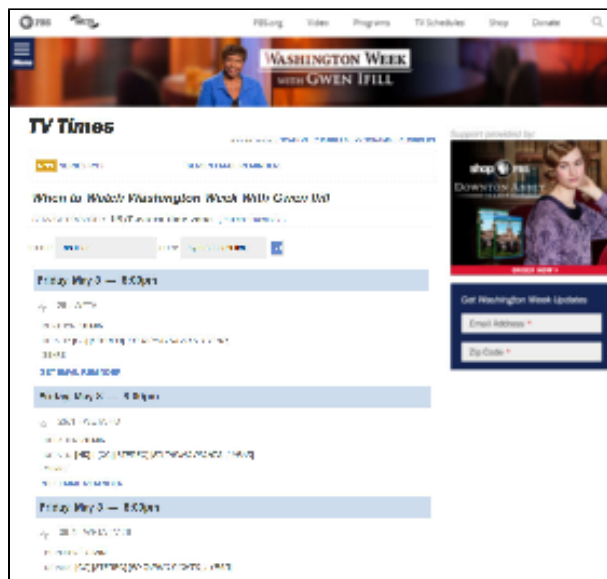

## Overview

A core part of the PBS user online experience is accessing tune-in information for both local and national programs. To serve that need, PBS Digital maintains a TV Schedules service in conjunction with ROVI data that provides stations and producers tools to display TV schedules on their sites.



## Key features

- Airdates for a given program display based on the user's local or selected station by default.
- Users can refine results based on series, episode, broadcast time, station, and specific station channels.
- Users can subscribe to email reminders for the series or an individual episode.
