

Updated production requirements - CMS review, no Drupal, page dimensions

PBS has updated two of its Web policies as outlined in the [Production Requirements](#) section of Producer Exchange:

1. All CMS plans must be reviewed by PBS at the start of any Web development project, and Drupal is not allowed for any new production due to repeated performance issues with high-traffic sites. This has been added as a new requirement at <http://docs.pbs.org/display/PX/Technical+Policies+and+Specifications>.
2. The maximum page dimensions requirement has been simplified, requiring only that Web pages be viewable without horizontal scrolling on a 1024 x 768 pixel screen resolution. This is an update to an existing requirement at <http://docs.pbs.org/display/PX/Editorial+Policies+and+Specifications>
